CAMP INFORMATION

Lodging: Some rooms will be available in the Ohio Christian University dormitories for families, couples, or individual accommodations for \$15.00 per night. Contact Mrs. Joanne Hawk at 740-572-0089 for reservations.

Meals: Meals will be served three times each day at the university dining room. Breakfast is \$5.00, Lunch \$7.00 and Supper \$7.00 or \$16 daily food card (advanced payment required for the daily food card option)

Teens: Teenagers 13-17 years of age may enroll in the camp meeting teen program. Housing and meals are included in the registration fee. The teen program begins on Tuesday afternoon June 20, and runs through Sunday afternoon, June 25. The camp registration will begin on **Tuesday, June 20 at 4:00 p.m. in the lobby at Ohio Christian University New Hall 2.** Early registration by June 10, 2017: \$100; after June 10 - \$120. OUR WORKERS



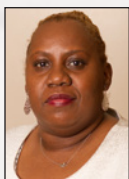
