Spiritual Warfare: The ongoing battle between good and evil, God and Satan, The Family of God and The Forces of Darkness, or the individual Believer and the Devil, I Peter 5:8.

2 Corinthians 10:3 - 5(NIV)

tells us that "Though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. ⁴The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. 5 We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ."

Much of the battle happens in our mind, which effects our attitudes and emotions. Each of the weapons mentioned in Ephesians 6:10 – 17 speak to specific ways we can guard ourselves. Notice that each of the armor pieces, except the last one: The Sword of The Spirit, which is the Word of God) is a defensive weapon. We are protected by these weapons. Our Sword teaches us more about our offensive weapons: prayer, proclamation of His promises, the displaying fruit of the Spirit, etc.
