I See - We have been able to purchase a kit from I-tec that provides everything we need to help check peoples eyes and it comes with 200 pairs of glasses! We are excited about how we can use this for our students as well as when we travel out to remote areas!

Discipleship Program - We are partnering with The Hardaways and Porters working to disciple students after they have left the Bible College. We will help sponsor students and then when they graduate they will go to church plants and we will disciple them for two years to help as they begin working in their culture that is contradictory to what they have learned.
